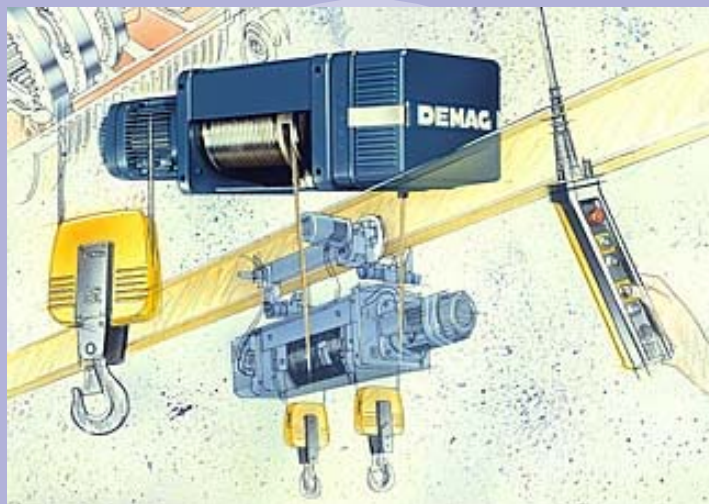
OSHA States:

Rule 1852: An employer shall train a prospective operator before their assignment as an operator of a crane.

Rule 1853: An employer shall test the knowledge and ability of an employee before authorizing him / her to operate a crane.

NOTICE!

NEW RULE 1854 AS OF APRIL 2002: AN EMPLOYER MUST PROVIDE AN EMPLOYEE WITH A PERMIT TO OPERATE A CRANE ONLY AFTER THE EMPLOYEE MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS PRESCRIBED IN RULE 11852 AND RULE 11853 ACCORDING TO A NEW GENERAL INDUSTRY SAFETY STANDARD FOR PART 18, OVERHEAD CRANES
